Physics is the study of matter and energy, from the smallest scale, as in the study of elementary particles, to the largest, as in the study of the astrophysics and cosmology. In this sense, physics is the science that underlies all of the other sciences. In principle, as well as in practice, physics is involved in virtually all scientific and technical endeavors, e.g., biophysics, geophysics, and medical physics.

A minor in Physics requires satisfactory completion of the following:

- Completion of **18** credit hours, with a minimum grade of **C** in each course
- Residency requirement - At least **6** credits must be completed at IUPUI (this does not include transfer credit, AP, or CLEP credit)
